Online Application is **compulsory** for incoming students

It is compulsory to complete all the data requested in the online application. Those students that do not complete the online application, within the stated deadline, will not be accepted.

Certificate required:

When filling in the online application your courses, those students that want to apply for the subject "Prácticas Externas" or "Practicas Tuteladas" (supervised external practices and rotations), they must present "Sexual Offences Certificate (*Certificado de Delitos de Naturaleza Sexual*)"

In accordance with Spanish legislation, specifically the Organic Law 1/1996 on the Legal Protection of Minors, amended by Law 26/2015 and Law 45/2015, anyone who intends to work or volunteer regularly with minors in any capacity in Spain must submit a Sexual Offences Certificate (*Certificado de Delitos de Naturaleza Sexual*) issued by the Spanish Central Sex Offenders Register (*Registro Central de Delincuentes Sexuales*). The Sexual Offences Certificate provides proof that an individual has no criminal record of sexual offences. This legislation applies to all students at the UGR who will be in regular contact with minors as part of their studies such as external practices. The Sexual Offences Certificate is the only valid certificate issued in Spain allowing students to work with children.



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You can be registered in a maximum of 60 ECTS for full academic year. If you are going to study here for just one semester, you may enroll a maximum of 30 ECTS credits. **Remember** Subjects are taught in **Spanish**.

- 1st term starts in early September and runs to mid-February (including extraordinary exams).
- 2nd term starts in the mid-February and mid-July (including extraordinary exams).

IMPORTANT: The final approval of courses is subject to the availability of places at the courses once you register and enroll at the University of Granada at the beginning of the semester.
